Dr. Anand is qualified medical doctor having advance degrees like MD (Preventive & Social Medicine, Community Medicine/Public Health), FHM., MHA., PDCR., BDCP., BSS as well as Bachelor of Legislative Laws(LLB). He has been recognized and awarded by National and International organizations for his dedicated service to the people in the field of HIV/AIDS including PARTON Award, Certificate of appreciation by LEPRA Society,



UNICEF, Indian Association of Preventive & Social Medicine, Rotary International of Chennai and others.

As a member of the NCPCR DR. R.G. Anand has conducted 250 health camps for orphans across Tamil Nadu and Puducherry. As a national-level trainer (NACO) he has trained more than 1000 doctors and 20,000 nurses in HIV/AIDS prevention and care. He has supported educational empowerment of about 2500 under-privileged children through 100 tuition centres under Seva Bharathi Tamil Nadu and organized more than 100 awareness camps on PM Welfare Schemes and had linked people with various welfare schemes of the Government through a dedicated team working on "PM Welfare Schemes in Tamil Nadu". He has travelled the length and breadth of our nation, covering 20 states and 175 districts, while visiting the children in institutions. In this initiative, he has interacted with more than 5000 children, promoting positive and safe behaviour and building their confidence during the Covid - 19 pandemic. Anand had personally supported thousands of people with food, care and helping in every way to empower their lives. 

BETI BACHAO BETI PADHAO & SUKANYA SAMRIDHI YOJANA



Our beloved Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modiji believes that "the happiness of a nation lies in the dignity of its daughters". With an overall goal to celebrate the girl child and enable her education, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao is being implemented by the Government of India under the able leadership of Modiji in the country. The objective of the scheme is to prevent sex-selective elimination and ensure survival protection, education, and participation of the Girl Child.

As a responsible citizen of the country, people are encouraged to raise daughters and sons as "equals," and secure admission and retention of girl child in schools. People should encourage girls to be independent and let them pursue a career of their choice. Efforts should be taken to make the neighbourhood safe and violence-free for women and girls. For women's empowerment, it is necessary to support women's right to inherit and own property as well as promote simple weddings.

To give wings to a daughter's dreams, Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana (SSY) is launched as a part of the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme. Parents can open accounts for two daughters, for a period of 21 years, or until the girl child marries after the age of 18. This is a useful government-backed savings scheme. It offers more returns than other savings schemes. Opening an account under this scheme provides triple tax benefit - principal invested, the interest earned, as well as the maturity amount is tax-free.

This multi-sectoral scheme is operational through three key ministries namely the Ministry of Women and Child Development (MoWCD), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), and the Ministry of Education (MoE).

This Diwali, can we arrange programmes to honour the Laxmi of India? If you look around, you'll find many daughters and daughters-in-law who are performing extraordinarily. Some must be engaged in teaching underprivileged children, others could be occupied in spreading awareness in the field of sanitation and health, while many could be doing society a service by working as Doctor and Engineers. Or striving for justice to someone by working as Lawyers!

Dr. Anand attended Ayudha Pooja celebrations at SP office, Trichy, organised by Anti Child Trafficking Unit. SUKANYA SAMRIDDHI SCHEME



In the words of our Prime Minister, empowerment of girl child is critical for economy's growth and development. Following the footsteps of the PM, Dr. Anand took the initiative to ensure financial inclusion and empowerment of girl child by encouraging them to bank account under Sukanya Samriddhi Scheme. This is first step towards financial self-reliance of girl in the society. Dr. Anand distributed bank account passbooks to 166 girls under the "SUKANYA SAMRIDDHI SCHEME". It created awareness amongst the people of Khammam, where it saw increase in the enquiry about benefits of the scheme. During the distribution event, the District Collector, Khammam, Telangana, was also present which boosted self-confidence of girls present in the meeting.

In continuation of his efforts to uplift morale of girls and break the social stigma around menstrual period, Dr. Anand introduced Udaan Scheme. Discussions were conducted on ways to enhance the health and wellness of the girl child during menstrual period. The open discussion around the menstrual period led to much needed breaking of the social stigma attached to it.

2. POSHAN MAAH- NUTRITION MONTH



"For our children and our students to display their optimum potential, show their mettle; nutrition and proper nourishment as well play a very big role. The month of September will be observed as Nutrition Month in the entire nation. Nation and nutrition are very closely inter-related. We have a maxim - "Yatha Annam Tatha Mannam," which means our mental and intellectual development is directly related to the quality of our food intake."

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modiji emphasized the importance of nutrition in our lives in the popular programme "Mann ki Baat". The thoughtful Modiji said that nutrition helps children and students attain their optimum potential. To address malnutrition amongst young children, and women and to ensure health and nutrition for everyone, the Government of India launched Poshan Abhiyaan, a multi-ministerial convergence mission with a vision to address malnutrition in a targeted approach. Poshan implies 'Prime Minister's Overarching Scheme for Holistic Mission'. As part of Poshan Abhiyaan, every year the month of September is celebrated as Rashtriya Poshan Maah to ensure community mobilization and bolster people's participation across the country.

Poshan Maah is a month-long activity focused on antenatal care, optimal breastfeeding, anaemia, growth monitoring, girl's education, diet, right age of marriage, hygiene and sanitation, and eating healthy (food fortification). During this month, activities focus on Social and Behavioural Change Communication (SBCC) based on Jan Andolan guidelines, one of the strategies under Poshan Abhiyaan. The objective of the Poshan Maah is to encourage Jan Bhagidaari, to create a Jan Andolan, for addressing malnutrition amongst young children, and women and to ensure health and nutrition for everyone.

Poshan Maah is a multi-sectoral initiative where the Ministry of Education, Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Aayush, and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare are committed to bringing nutrition on focus through their multiple activities and verticals.

'Proper nutrition is vital to build a prosperous nation,' says Prime Minister Narendra Modi. In order to support the initiatives taken by Modiji in ensuring proper nutrition to people in India, Dr. Anand organized Nutrition Month in the city of Trichy, Tamil Nadu. He also ensured the involvement of management and students of Jamal Mohamed College, Trichy, for wider dissemination of information of a critical initiative of Modi government in India. The event has definitely led to better awareness on Nutrition related issues in State.

4. ACCESSIBLE INDIA CAMPAIGN-SUGAMYA BHARAT ABHIYAN



Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modiji coined the term 'Divyang' instead of 'Viklang' to drive change in the mindset for a more inclusive New India. The government undertook various initiatives to ensure that 'Divyang' are offered equal opportunities and provided necessary institutional support to help them become self-reliant. Accessible India Campaign (Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan) was launched to provide universal accessibility for the Divyangs across the country. The Accessible India Campaign aims to remove barriers of all kinds, structural or physical, in public space for Divyangs to help live a normal life like everyone else.

Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan (SBA) has three separate components namely Built Environment Accessibility, Transportation System Accessibility, and Information and Communication Eco-system accessibility. Under the Built Environment component, measures have been taken to eliminate obstacles and barriers to indoor and outdoor facilities including schools, medical facilities, and workplaces. It also includes footpaths, curb cuts, and obstacles that block the flow of pedestrian traffic.

Under the Transportation System component, an effort has been taken to enhance the proportion of accessible airports, railway stations, and public transportation. Under the ICT Eco-system component, the government is committed to enhancing the proportion of accessible and usable public documents and websites that meet internationally recognized accessibility standards. It also includes enhancing the pool of sign language interpreters, enhancing the proportion of daily captioning and sign-language interpretation of public television news programmes. The SBA is being implemented by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India across the country.

SWACHH BHARAT MISSION



"A clean India would be the best tribute India could pay to Mahatma Gandhi on his 150th birth anniversary in 2019," said Shri Narendra Modi during the launch of Swachh Bharat Mission on 2nd October 2014. Swachh Bharat Mission was launched to accelerate the efforts to achieve universal sanitation coverage and to put the focus on sanitation across the country.

Modiji invited people to participate in the cleanliness drive, the Swachhta Abhiyan which has turned into a National Movement. Millions of people across the country have joined the cleanliness initiatives through government departments, NGOs, and local community centres to make India clean. It has led to a sense of responsibility among the citizens for the Clean India movement, an idea propounded by Mahatma Gandhi. Cleanliness campaigns to spread awareness about hygiene through audio songs, plays and music has become a regular feature across the nation.





Activities to promote better hygiene and good practice is being conducted across schools in the country. It includes hand-washing, cleanliness drive to reduce ill effects on children's health. Activities targeted for school children are aimed at reducing death from water-borne disease, stop open-defecation, and contaminated food. Under the mission, all villages, Gram Panchayats, districts, states and union territories in India declared themselves "open-defecation free" (ODF) by 2 October 2019, by constructing over 100 million toilets in rural India. The mission is being implemented by the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Government of India.

To realize the dream of PM, Dr.Anand actively participated in Swachh Bharat and Annadhanam function organized at Pudukottai Town. He interacted with people involved in Swachh Bharat Mission. He felicitated them with clothes and served food himself as mark of respect to them. It was a nice way of saying thank you to people working towards Swachh Bharat Mission. This initiative led to pride and self-respect amongst people of the town. This led to sensitization of people on cleanliness and hygiene in the city.

6. UJJAWALA SCHEME



Trafficking of women and children for commercial sexual exploitation is an organized crime that violates basic human rights. Poverty, low status of women, and lack of a protective environment are cited as some of the causes of trafficking. Ujjawala - Comprehensive Scheme for Prevention of Trafficking for Rescue, Rehabilitation, and Re-Integration of Victims of Trafficking for Commercial Sexual Exploitation was launched to prevent trafficking and to rescue and rehabilitate victims in the country. Ujjawala is a multi-sectoral approach to tackle trafficking and provide relief to victims. The objectives of the Ujjawala scheme are:

- Prevent trafficking of women and children for commercial sexual exploitation through social mobilization and involvement of local communities, awareness generation programmes, generate public discourse through training, workshops/seminars and such events and any other innovative activity.
- Facilitate rescue of victims from the place of their exploitation and place them in safe custody.
- Provide rehabilitation services both immediate and long-term to the victims by providing basic amenities/needs such as shelter, food, clothing, medical treatment including counselling, legal aid and guidance, and vocational training.
- Facilitate reintegration of the victims into the family and the society, at large.
- Facilitate the repatriation of cross-border victims to their country of origin.

The scheme is being implemented by the Ministry of Women and Child Development in coordination with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice, and Ministry of Finance.

Dr. Anand follows vision of our PM sincerely and honestly. He hoisted BJYM in Pudukkottai district at a function being organized for PM's Ujjwala Yojana function. The event was attended by people from across the city.

ENACTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE ACT, 2015



Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi implemented the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015, which ensures the protection of the rights of juveniles and at the same time tackles the heinous offenses committed by persons in the age group 16-18 years. The Act has provisions to make a more robust, effective, and responsive legislative framework for children in need of care and protection as well as children in conflict with the law.

The Act clearly defines and classifies offenses as petty, serious and heinous, and defined differentiated processes for each category. Keeping in view the increasing number of serious offenses being committed by persons in the age group of 16-18 years, the Juvenile Justice Board will assess if the crime was committed as a 'child' or as an 'adult'. This unique instrument brings about a balance between the rights of the child, protect legitimate interests, and yet conscious of the need to deter crimes, especially brutal crimes against women.

The Act has streamlined adoption procedures for orphaned, abandoned, and surrendered children by providing statutory status to the Child Adoption Resources Authority (CARA). The Act provides various rehabilitation and social integration measures for institutional and non-institutional children. It also provided for sponsorship and foster care as completely new measures. New offenses including illegal adoption, corporal punishment in childcare institutions, the use of children by militant groups, and offenses against disabled children were also incorporated in the proposed legislation. The Act provides a robust mechanism to deal with offenses by juveniles and establish a strong framework to provide care and protection to children and streamline the process of adoption.

Chennai Youth Justice Committee President, Hon'ble Justice Ms. Shanmuga Priya met the Hon'ble member of National Children's Rights Protection Commission Dr. R.G. Anand. The meeting held at the Chennai Youth Judiciary Office discussed the challenges of the curfew and the pending cases. Even in this difficult time, the cases are being investigated immediately and the appropriate solution is being provided.





8. AMENDMENT OF POCSO ACT



Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has time and again expressed his desire for the upliftment of every person in society. To ensure the protection of a child from sexual offenses, Modiji implemented the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act 2019, which is a comprehensive law that aims to safeguard the interest of children while including child-friendly mechanisms at every stage of the judicial process.

he POCSO Act 2019 makes punishment more stringent for committing sexual crimes against children including the death penalty. The amendments provide for the levy of fines and imprisonment to curb child pornography. The Act defines child pornography in a clear manner which also includes an image created, adapted, modified to depict a child in cartoons, animated pictures, etc. The amendment Act is expected to discourage the trend of child sexual abuse by acting as a deterrent due to strong penal provisions incorporated in the Act.

The gender-neutral Act respects the best interests and welfare of the person below the age of 18 years and provides paramount importance at every stage, to ensure the healthy physical, emotional, intellectual, and social development of the child. This Act ensures that no crime against children should be taken lightly and at the same time, protects the dignity of the vulnerable children at the time of distress. POCSO 2019 also makes the Centre and State government accountable for designing an age-appropriate curriculum that would make children aware of how to protect their physical and virtual identities.

Hon'ble Member of National Children's Rights Protection Commission, Dr. R.G. Anand, met Madras High Court Justice and President of Tamil Nadu POCSO Committee, Hon'ble Mr. P.N. Prakash to discuss about the recent POCSO cases in Tamil Nadu. Hon'ble Justice is conducting quick investigation on crimes against children to prevent such cases. The Hon'ble Justice provided various suggestions to National Children's Rights Protection Commission to control crimes. Hon'ble Mr. Prakash is highly experienced senior judge who has successfully handled various cases in last 36 years.

Tamil Nadu POCSO team led by Shri P.N. Prakash is ensuring intense surveillance across Tamil Nadu to prevent crimes. Shri Prakash assured for speedy trials against criminals. NEW EDUCATION POLICY



Prime Minister Narendra Modiji announced the New Education Policy (NEP) to make India self-reliant and open up the education sector for facilitating greater global exposure for Indian students. Modiji asserted that India will establish itself as a global education destination. Modiji said that studying should not just be limited to the walls of the classroom but interlinked with the outside world. NEP is envisaged as a foundation of the future of India. The New Education Policy will give a direction to 21st century India.

The new NEP proposes a "5+3+3+4" design corresponding to the age groups 3-8 years (foundational stage), 8-11 (preparatory), 11-14 (middle), and 14-18 (secondary). This brings early childhood education (also known as pre-school education for children of ages 3 to 5) under the ambit of formal schooling. The mid-day meal programme will be extended to pre-school children. The NEP suggests students up to Class 5 may be taught in their mother tongue or regional language.

The NEP proposes sweeping changes including opening up of Indian higher education to foreign universities, replacing the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) with the Education Commission of India, the introduction of the four-year multidisciplinary undergraduate programme with multiple exit options, and discontinuation of the M Phil programme, flexibility to institutions to offer different designs for Master's programmes and setting up of a National Research Foundation.

It is expected that NEP will make learning a fun-based experience and prepare students for the future with new skills including critical thinking, creativity, communication, and curiosity.

10. ENSURING THE SAFETY OF CHILDREN DURING COVID



The safety of children and women is the top priority of the Narendra Modi government. It was proven during the current crisis that emerged due to COVID-19 in the country. Modi government undertook various measures through different Ministries to ensure the safety of children during COVID. The Modi government had launched cybercrime.gov.in to facilitate victims and complainants report cybercrime complaints online.

The Ministry of Women and Child Development develops a document that highlights the coping strategy for children and caregivers during COVID. The document highlights that it is important to stay positive as well as honest while communicating with children. Limit

the family's exposure to news coverage of the specific event, including social media. Talk with children in an age-appropriate method about all the things that are happening to keep people safe and healthy. The Ministry suggested to engage children in developmental /creative activities and also structure their day.

All schools and colleges have been closed to ensure the safety of children. Various Standard Operating Protocols have been issued by the government which talks about the safety of children. Children wearing colourful dresses sitting in a pattern were absent during the Independence Day celebration on Red Fort. Modiji said that "Today, our children are not here with us. The COVID has halted all of us". It was done to ensure the safety of children.

Dr. Anand has expertise in understanding the psychological needs of child. He was invited to share his thoughts and provide necessary guidance to raise children to overcome the challenges in developing India. He interacted live on Facebook with Shivani Sharma Singh from Helping Human Rights Foundation. During the conversation, he enlightened the participants on COVID-19 pandemic and symptoms in children.



Dr. Anand has work tirelessly to raise awareness and sensitize people about the mental state of a child during COVID-19. He joined a webinar as a keynote speaker on the topic "Mental health issues being faced by children during COVID-19 pandemic; ways to overcome," on June 13, 2020 which was attended by sector experts. 11. E-PATHSHALA



The Digital India Campaign of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has promoted extensive use of ICTs in the teaching-learning process. ePathshala is a mobile app and website portal, which has been jointly launched by the Ministry of Education and National Council of Educational Research and Training on 7th November 2015. It was launched during the National Conference on ICT in School Education. It has been developed for showcasing and disseminating all educational e-resources including textbooks, audio, video, periodicals, and a variety of other digital resources.

E-Pathshala is used as a platform to provide free access to all NCERT books from class 1 to 12 for students, teachers, and parents. These books are freely available to all and can be accessed on mobile phones and also be downloaded in pdf format. Students, teachers, educators, and parents can access eBooks through multiple technology platforms that is mobile phones and tablets, and from the web portal through laptops and desktops. E-pathshala also allows users to carry as many books as their device supports. Features of these books allow users to pinch, select, zoom, bookmark, highlight, navigate, share, listen to text using text to speech (TTS) apps, and make notes digitally.

E-pathshala is not only helping poor and needy students but also helping the nation to achieve the Sustainable Development Goal no. 4 which ensures inclusive, equitable, quality education and promoting lifelong learning for all.

The caring Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modiji has started an annual interaction session with students across the country. Modiji interacts with students appearing for school examinations to overcome the fear of examinations and enjoy the 'festival of examination' or 'Pariksha Parv'. 13. ENROLMENT OF CHILDREN BELOW 6 YEARS UNDER AADHAR



The visionary Prime Minister Narendra Modiji had last September given the directive to ensure universal enrolment under the Aadhar scheme and to track children from birth. The aim is to enrol children below 6 years of age. As per record, only a quarter of the residents in the age group 0-5 years are enrolled in Aadhar. At the same time, close to 96% of adults are enrolled in Aadhar. As per the direction of Modiji, The UIDAI initiated plans to click infants in the hospital cradle itself and link their pictures to the details of their parents for generating Aadhaar numbers. The authority is working in 'campaign mode' to expedite Aadhaar enrolments in this age group. It is expected that Aadhar will be issued to almost every resident after crossing the 100-crore mark of Aadhar enrolments in the country.

The UIDAI is working with other agencies to ensure giving Aadhar to children at the time of birth in the hospital itself. This is made possible after relaxation in the rules of Aadhar where new-born and young children no longer have to give their biometric details to get enrolled under the Aadhaar scheme. Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) can now issue Aadhar cards to children below 5 years of age even if the child's photograph is unavailable or if the child has no name. Enrolment of children in Aadhar will help deliver services like immunization, health benefits, and education or any other such schemes to the infants before they turn five based on the Aadhaar number.

15. ATMANIRBHAR BHARAT



Prime Minister Narendra Modiji announced an economic stimulus package of INR 20 lakh crore (10% of GDP) under the 'Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan'. This is evident from the fact that from zero production of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) before March 2020, India today has created a capacity of producing 2 lakh PPE kits on daily basis. The clarion call given by the Hon'ble PM to use these trying times to become Atma Nirbhar (self-reliant) has been very well received and expected to result in the resurgence of the Indian economy. The Atma Nirbhar Bharat focuses on five pillars namely Economy, Infrastructure, System, Vibrant Demography, and Demand. The AtmaNirbhar Bharat is rolled out in five phases; Phase-I: Businesses including MSMEs, Phase-II: Poor, including migrants and farmers, Phase-III: Agriculture, Phase-IV: New Horizons of Growth, and Phase-V: Government Reforms and Enablers.

16. JAN DHANYOJANA



Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) is National Mission for Financial Inclusion was launched in the year 2014. It envisages universal access to banking facilities with at least one basic banking account for every household, financial literacy, access to credit, insurance, and pension. Initially launched for 4 years, the Government has extended the comprehensive PMJDY program with the change in focus on opening accounts from "every household" to "every adult". The benefits of Jan Dhan Yojana are:

- One basic savings bank account is opened for an unbanked person.
- No requirement to maintain any minimum balance.
- Interest is earned on the deposit in PMJDY accounts.
- Rupay Debit card is provided to PMJDY account holder.
- Accident Insurance Cover of INR 1 lakh (enhanced to Rs. 2 lakhs to new PMJDY accounts opened after 28.8.2018) is available with a RuPay card issued to the PMJDY account holders.
- Life Insurance Cover of Rs. 30,000 to eligible PMJDY account holders who opened their accounts between 15.8.2014 to 31.1.2015.
- An overdraft (OD) facility up to Rs. 10,000 to eligible account holders
- PMJDY accounts are eligible for Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT), Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY), Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY), Atal Pension Yojana (APY), Micro Units Development and Refinance Agency Bank (MUDRA) scheme.

As of now, there are 41.38 crores beneficiaries of this scheme across the country. A total of INR 130932.33 crores was deposited in these accounts. Also, Rupay debit cards are issued to 30.33 crore account holders. The scheme is being implemented under the guidance of the Ministry of Finance.

17. 150 ANNIVERSARY OF GANDHIJI



On the occasion of Mahatma Gandhi's 150 birth anniversary, Prime Minister Narendra Modiji said the Father of the Nation envisioned Indian nationalism as one that was "never narrow or exclusive", but one that worked for "the service of humanity". 
